COMPLAINT FOR VIOLATION OF NORTH CAROLINA UNFAIR AND DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICES ACT, NEGLIGENT MISREPRESENTATION, INTENTIONAL INFLICTION OF EMOTIONAL DISTRESS, AND PUBLIC NUISANCE

JURY TRIAL DEMANDED

Now, comes the Plaintiff David B. Wheeler and makes the complaint as follows:

INTRODUCTION

- 1. Plaintiff David B. Wheeler ("Plaintiff"), a resident of Mitchell County, North Carolina, initiates this complaint against Defendant Donald J. Trump ("Defendant"), both individually and in his capacity as titular head of his presidential campaign entities.
- 2. Plaintiff alleges violations of the North Carolina Unfair and Deceptive Trade Practices Act, Negligent Misrepresentation, Public Nuisance, and Intentional Infliction of Emotional Distress. This case arises from Defendant's persistent and deliberate dissemination of false, misleading, and incendiary statements during the 2023-2024 Presidential Campaign, causing significant, measurable harm to Plaintiff and the broader public. Defendant's

- misconduct has caused irreparable harm to Plaintiff's emotional well-being, sense of safety, and financial stability, necessitating therapeutic care and life-altering protective measures.
- 3. The cumulative emotional distress has compelled Plaintiff to consider drastic steps to protect himself and his family. These include initiating the sale of his home in North Carolina, obtaining passports for his three children, and researching relocation options to escape potential harassment or violence instigated by Defendant's supporters. Plaintiff has even contemplated purchasing a firearm for self-defense, a measure in stark contrast to his prior principles. These burdens are compounded by the extraordinary financial and emotional strain Plaintiff has endured while repairing his home following the devastation of Hurricane Helene.

PARTIES

- 4. Plaintiff: David B. Wheeler is an individual residing in Mitchell County, North Carolina.
- 5. **Defendant:** Donald J. Trump is a resident of Florida, a public figure, and an individual who engages in interstate commerce, including campaign fundraising, solicitation of donations, and political appearances within North Carolina.

AMOUNT IN CONTROVERSY

6. The amount in controversy exceeds \$25,000, reflecting the substantial damages Plaintiff has incurred, including but not limited to financial losses, costs of therapy and protective measures, and emotional harm.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

7. This Court possesses jurisdiction under N.C.G.S. § 75-1.1, as well as general principles of tort and declaratory relief.

8. Venue is appropriate in Mitchell County, as Plaintiff resides in this jurisdiction, and Defendant's unlawful conduct caused actionable harm within this county.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

9. Throughout the 2023-2024 campaign cycle, Defendant Donald J. Trump engaged in a pervasive pattern of knowingly false, misleading, and inflammatory public statements while campaigning in North Carolina. Defendant's conduct included intentional misrepresentations and inflammatory statements that directly endangered public safety and Plaintiff's well-being. Defendant's reckless and harmful statements fostered instability, undermined trust in public institutions, and created actionable harm for Plaintiff. These include, but are not limited to, the following:

a. False Promise to Lower Grocery Costs

- Statement: "If I am elected, grocery costs will drop so quickly your head will spin."
- Fact: In November 2024, Defendant publicly admitted that reducing grocery costs immediately was impossible given economic conditions (Source: NBC News).
- Impact: Plaintiff relied on this statement as a promise of financial relief. The failure of this promise caused severe emotional distress, frustration, and financial strain.

b. False Promise to End the Russia-Ukraine War

• Statement: "I will end the Russia-Ukraine war in 24 hours after I take office."

- Fact: Experts, including foreign policy analysts, debunked this claim as impractical and unfounded (Source: Associated Press, January 2024).
- Impact: Plaintiff experienced emotional harm due to false hopes of relief from the impact of global fuel and food price inflation.

c. False Claims About FEMA Disaster Relief

- Statement: "Democrats in North Carolina are deliberately withholding aid from Republican areas affected by Hurricane Helene."
- Fact: FEMA officials confirmed that aid distribution was equitable and non-partisan (Source: FEMA Press Release, October 2023).
- Impact: Plaintiff suffered significant emotional distress from fear that his community was targeted, coupled with financial burdens of repairing his home after Hurricane Helene.

d. Threats of Retribution Against Non-Supporters

- Statement: "We're going to have retribution. If you don't support me, you're against me, and we know what happens to people who work against us."
- Fact: Plaintiff received credible threats against his life via X.com messaging, text messages, email and voicemails. These include the following sample screenshots of messages received by Plaintiff. These are three of more than 100 messages received by Plaintiff.



A transcript of a voicemail left for Plaintiff by Todd Paul Genuit of Dallas, Texas:

"Hey you tranny loving faggots. You are so lucky that I'm not the preacher. See, he's going after legal way. I'm gonna come up there with a bat and bash skulls and burn your houses down, you'd never know it was me. And you are cocksuckers. Literally, you tranny cocksuckers. So go fuck yourself. Thanks."

• Fact: Defendant's own lawsuit filed in December 2024 against Selzer & Co., the Des Moines Register & Tribune Co, and Gannet, Inc, accused pollsters of election interference and misrepresentation, highlighting his awareness of the harm caused by false information. Yet, Defendant continues to knowingly disseminate false and inflammatory statements that endanger public trust, incite hostility, and cause widespread emotional harm (Source: *Trump v. Selzer, Polk County Court, Des Moines, IA*)

• Impact: Plaintiff received credible threats, forcing him to consider relocating his family, asking law enforcement for protection, potentially selling his home and moving out of state, and purchasing a firearm for self-defense, despite his principled opposition to gun ownership. These measures have caused severe emotional distress.

e. False Claims About Debate Victories

- Statement: "According to the polls, I won every single debate, Republican and against Hillary."
- Fact: Independent polling showed Hillary Clinton won the majority of debates in 2016 (Source: FactCheck.org).
- Impact: Defendant's misleading narrative undermined trust in public discourse and caused Plaintiff emotional distress.

f. False Claim About 2020 Election Fraud in North Carolina

- Statement: "We won North Carolina by a landslide in 2020, but they tried to steal it from us just like in other states."
- Fact: Official results confirmed that no evidence of fraud was found (Source: North Carolina State Board of Elections, 2020).
- Impact: Plaintiff suffered anxiety and distrust in democratic processes due to Defendant's baseless claims.

g. False Claim About Healthcare Costs

- **Statement:** "If I'm re-elected, your healthcare premiums will drop immediately by 60 to 70 percent."
- Fact: No actionable plan to lower healthcare costs was presented, and experts debunked this claim as impossible (Source: Kaiser Family Foundation).
- Impact: Relying on this statement, Plaintiff experienced heightened financial strain and frustration.

h. False Statements About Migrant Crime in North Carolina

- Statement: "Migrants are flooding into North Carolina, committing crimes at unprecedented levels."
- Fact: North Carolina crime data reveals no correlation between immigration and rising crime rates (Source: NCDPS).
- Impact: These statements incited community hostility and fear, causing Plaintiff severe anxiety and emotional distress.

i. False Claim About North Carolina Jobs

- **Statement:** "Biden destroyed 50,000 jobs in North Carolina, and I'm the only one who can bring them back."
- Fact: North Carolina employment data showed steady job growth (Source: Bureau of Labor Statistics).
- Impact: Plaintiff suffered economic anxiety as a result of these false assertions.

j. False Claims About Economic Conditions

- Statement: "Our economy was the best it's ever been under my leadership, and it collapsed because of my opponents."
- Fact: The economic downturn in 2020 was caused primarily by the global COVID-19 pandemic (Source: U.S. Federal Reserve).
- Impact: Defendant's misrepresentation caused Plaintiff financial distress and heightened frustration over economic uncertainty.

FIRST CLAIM FOR RELIEF: VIOLATION OF N.C.G.S. § 75-1.1 (UNFAIR AND DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICES ACT)

- 10. Plaintiff incorporates all preceding allegations by reference.
- 11. Defendant engaged in unfair and deceptive acts and practices in commerce by disseminating knowingly false and misleading statements during campaign fundraising, public speeches, and solicitations.
- 12. Defendant's conduct constitutes a violation of the North Carolina Unfair and Deceptive Trade Practices Act, N.C.G.S. § 75-1.1, as it deceived the public, including Plaintiff, for personal and political gain.
- 13. Plaintiff suffered actual damages as a direct and proximate result of Defendant's actions, including financial losses, emotional distress, and costs related to personal safety measures in excess of \$25,000.
- 14. Pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 75-16, Plaintiff is entitled to treble damages, reasonable attorney's fees, and injunctive relief prohibiting Defendant's further deceptive conduct.

SECOND CLAIM FOR RELIEF: NEGLIGENT MISREPRESENTATION

- 15. Plaintiff incorporates all preceding allegations by reference.
- 16. Defendant made false and misleading statements to the public, including Plaintiff, without exercising reasonable care to ensure their accuracy.
- 17. Defendant's statements included promises of financial relief, safety assurances, and policy changes that lacked any factual or actionable basis.
- 18. Plaintiff reasonably relied on Defendant's misrepresentations, which caused foreseeable harm, including financial strain, emotional distress, and disruption to his personal and family life in excess of \$25,000.
- 19. As a direct result of Defendant's negligent misrepresentations, Plaintiff incurred financial expenses, emotional harm, and the burden of taking drastic protective measures in excess of \$25,000.

THIRD CLAIM FOR RELIEF: INTENTIONAL INFLICTION OF EMOTIONAL DISTRESS

- 20. Plaintiff incorporates all preceding allegations by reference.
- 21. Defendant engaged in extreme and outrageous conduct by making false, inflammatory, and threatening statements that incited fear, hostility, and harassment.
- 22. Defendant knew or should have known that such conduct would cause severe emotional distress to members of the public, including Plaintiff.

- 23. Plaintiff suffered severe emotional distress, including anxiety, fear for his safety, nightmares, and psychological trauma, requiring therapy and other protective measures in excess of \$25,000.
- 24. Defendant's conduct incited hostility, distrust, and division within the community, directly harming Plaintiff's emotional health and financial stability.
- 25. Ironically, Defendant acknowledged the dangers of misinformation in his December 2024 lawsuit vs. Seltzer & Co, Gannett, and the Des Moines Register, where he alleged that misleading polling data constituted "election interference" and "fraud." By knowingly spreading false claims, Defendant engaged in the same conduct he condemned, amplifying public harm and creating widespread panic.
- 26. Defendant's intentional or reckless disregard for the consequences of his rhetoric directly caused Plaintiff's extreme emotional harm in excess of \$25,000.

FOURTH COUNT FOR RELIEF: PUBLIC NUISANCE

- 27. Plaintiff incorporates all preceding allegations by reference.
- 28. Defendant's repeated false and inflammatory statements disrupted public order, created widespread fear, and endangered community safety.
- 29. Defendant's conduct incited hostility, distrust, and division within the community, directly harming Plaintiff's emotional health and financial stability including death threats, threats to "burn down your home," and personal threats.
- 30. Plaintiff experienced direct harm as a result of Defendant's creation of a public nuisance, including emotional turmoil, financial burden, and the extraordinary need for protective measures to ensure his and his family's safety in excess of \$25,000.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests that the Court:

- 1. Award actual damages to compensate for financial losses, therapy costs, and emotional harm;
- 2. Award treble damages pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 75-16 for Defendant's violation of N.C.G.S.;
- 3. Award punitive damages to punish and deter Defendant's egregious misconduct;
- 4. Issue injunctive relief prohibiting Defendant from further disseminating false or inflammatory statements that endanger Plaintiff or the public;
- 5. Award Plaintiff reasonable attorney's fees and litigation costs;
- 6. Plaintiffs receive trial by jury of all issues so triable;
- 7. Grant such other relief as the Court deems just and proper.
