I am writing today to request your organization investigate the actions of Windsor, Colorado, resident, Lauren Opal Boebert (DOB 12/19/1986), based upon the following facts:

1. In May and June 2022, I had numerous emails, text messages, and recorded phone calls with Ms. Jessica Spaulding of Rifle, Colorado. Ms. Spaulding was a school friend and former employee of Boebert's. Ms. Spaulding volunteered to me that Boebert was a **frequent user of illegal methamphetamine**. Ms. Spaulding told me she personally witnessed her, "... *hotboxing meth with Jayson (Boebert) at a man camp....*" Please see "Attachment 1".
2. Ms. Spaulding also relayed an episode **where guns were drawn and she was threatened by Boebert** at a bar in Grand Junction, Colorado, when Spaulding expressed her support for Hillary Clinton in the 2016 election. Boebert said, "I'll shoot you in your face if you tell me you voted for Hillary Clinton." Please see "Attachment 1".
3. On June 16, 2022, I had a recorded phone call with Mr. Joshua Bartlett of Glenwood Springs, Colorado. During this recorded call, Mr. Bartlett volunteered to say that he and his wife personally **observed Boebert using illegal methamphetamine at her residence**. Please see "Attachment 2".
4. On September 10, 2023, Boebert was videotaped using a **vaping device with marijuana** at the Beetlejuice play at the Buell Theater in Denver, Colorado. Please see "Attachment 3".
5. On December 10, 2023, Boebert was **cut-off from consuming alcohol due to being drunk** at an event in New York, NY. Please see "Attachment 4".
6. In October 2010, Boebert was subject to a complaint filed with the Garfield Sheriff's office for **"harassment"**. Please see "Attachment 5".
7. Over the last 15 years, Boebert has been involved **in numerous domestic violence matters** that have resulted in her filing and be subject to protective orders. Please see "Attachment 6.1, 6.2, 6.3, 6.4, & 6.5."
8. In May 2020, Boebert was subject to an **injunction by the Garfield Health Department**. Please see "Attachment 7".
9. In April 2024, Boebert was subject to a **"distrainment warrant" by the Colorado Department of Revenue**. Please see "Attachment 8".
10. Boebert has a criminal rap sheet with more than **20 items**. Please see "Attachment 9".
11. Boebert claims to **carry a gun with her at all times** making her gun licensure subject to revocation under Colorado and United States laws. Please see "Attachment 10".
12. On June 20, 2015, according to Colorado Newline, "*Boebert was detained on June 20, 2015, **after a verbal altercation with police at Country Jam**, a music festival near **Grand Junction**. Boebert, then 28 years old, allegedly shouted at people detained on suspicion of underage drinking, urging them to flee from police,*

*which caused the young drinkers to become unruly. While she was being handcuffed for disorderly conduct, Boebert tried to twist away from police, according to deputies' reports. She allegedly shouted that her arrest was unconstitutional, that "she had friends at Fox News and that the arrest would be national news." See "Attachment 11."*

13. On Dec. 1, 2015, Boebert **was arrested by Garfield Sheriff's deputies for failure to appear**, according to Colorado Bureau of Investigation arrest records. Please see "Attachments 6 & 11".
14. Boebert was **arrested and booked into the Garfield County Jail** on Feb. 13, 2017, for failure to appear, according to Garfield County Sheriff records. Please see "Attachment 6".
15. On October 10, 2011, and again on April 6, 2017, Boebert was cited by the State of Colorado for one count of not using a seat belt and **two counts of not using a seat belt for 2 children**. See "Attachment 12 & 12.1".

Based upon this information, I am respectfully requesting an immediate investigation into these serious allegations, including Boebert's illegal ownership of a firearm while allegedly using illegal drugs, her excessive use of alcohol, her criminal recidivism, and her clear lack of respect for the law.

In addition, based upon the recent case law, it should be investigated whether she was using illegal drugs or an alcoholic or drunk when she applied for a gun permit(s).

I believe Boebert is a ticking time bomb and she needs to be relieved of her firearms pending an investigation into the actions above. No one is above the law, including a Member of Congress. She must be held accountable for her actions.

I am available via phone, video conference, or email anytime, and will provide whatever additional documents you request.

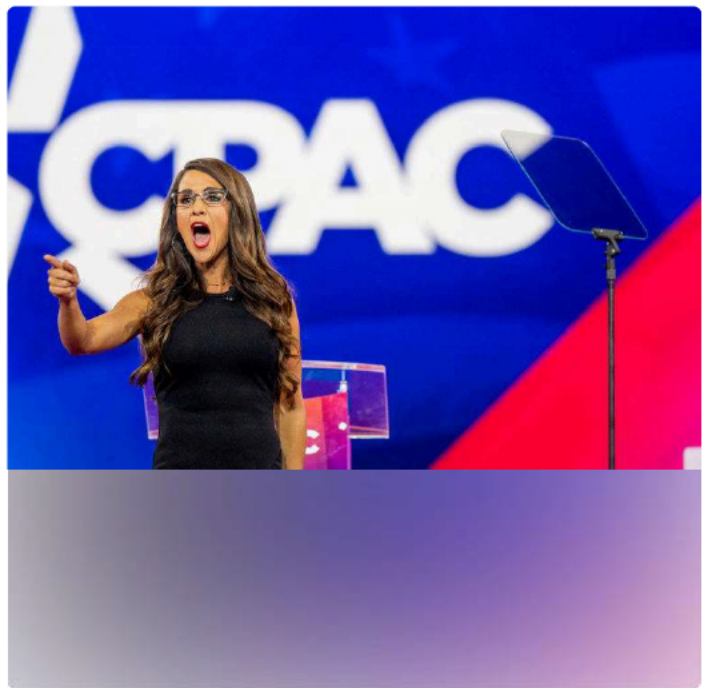

## Lauren Boebert was cut off from drinking more alcohol at a GOP gala says report, as controversies stack up ahead of new election bid

She was attending the New York Young Republican Club's annual gala when event staff cut her off from being served more alcohol, multiple witnesses told CNN.

The Colorado Congresswoman was seated at the same table as event headliner Donald Trump, and her frequent attempts at snapping selfies with him prompted his security detail to ask her to stop.

Despite the awkward interaction, [Trump endorsed Boebert](#) last month.

"Congresswoman Lauren Boebert is a Proven Conservative and Effective Leader who delivers for Colorado, and our America First agenda," he wrote on Truth Social.

Boebert is capitalizing on his backing and has run a [campaign ad touting the former president's support](#).

The December incident came just three months after she apologized for her [disruptive behavior at a Beetlejuice performance](#) in Denver.

Surveillance footage also appeared to show Boebert [being fondled by her date](#) before the two were kicked out.

Boebert, 37, was escorted out of a theater in September for disrupting fellow patrons by using her phone, vaping, and singing loudly.

She was booted from the venue alongside her male companion.

"People were freaking out about me dancing in the seat at 'Beetlejuice,'" [mused Boebert at the time](#). "Well, they should see me in church."

Recent events in her personal life that have made headlines include the [arrest of her son Tyler Boebert](#), the [double arrest of her ex-husband](#), and her [divorce](#),


Boebert remains determined to prove her worth as a serious legislator while maintaining her identity as a MAGA warrior.

Some Republican colleagues have come to her defense, insisting that her personal reputation has not interfered with her political career.

"It hasn't encumbered her job performance," GOP Rep. Byron Donalds of Florida told CNN.

But Boebert has feuded with fellow Republicans, including another highly controversial Republican woman in Congress, Rep. [Marjorie Taylor Greene](#).

She has also been [accused of "carpetbagging"](#) as she switches districts and seeks election in a new seat in rural Colorado.


She switched to Colorado's 4th district in December, after the narrow of victory in 2022, when Boebert won the 3rd congressional district, beating Democrat Adam Frisch by just 546 votes.

The Republican she is seeking to replace has been scathing of Boebert.

She "makes George Santos look like a saint," said former Rep. Ken Buck, referring to the recently expelled New York Republican who's known for his myriad lies.

To overcome the negative headlines, Boebert is leaning on her record as a conservative congresswoman, citing achievements such as the Pueblo Jobs Act, her active participation in district forums, and the backing from Trump.

"President Donald J. Trump has endorsed America-First warrior Lauren Boebert for Congress," says a narrator in her TV ad.

# Congressional candidate Lauren Boebert has a history of minor arrests, court no-shows

Rifle Republican has been arrested and summonsed four times in the past decade

Congressional candidate [Lauren Boebert](#) — who often espouses a pro-police, law-and-order message on the campaign trail — has been arrested and summonsed at least four times over the past decade, records show.

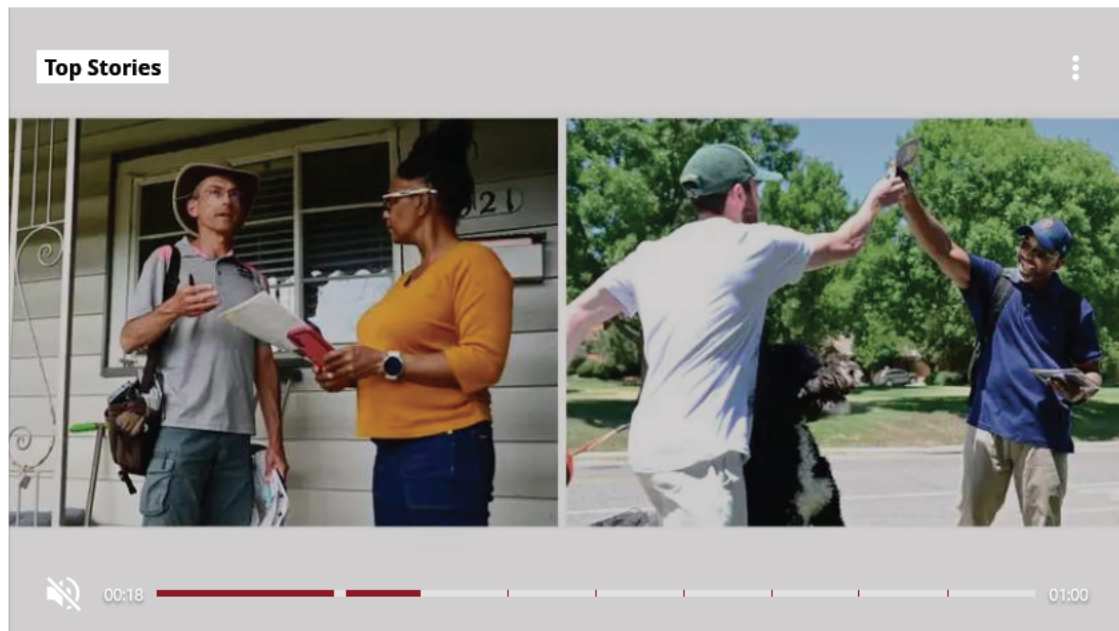
While the three arrests and one court-ordered summons were for petty crimes — and in one case all charges were dropped — Boebert's record is unusually long for a congressional candidate. It has become a campaign issue as the Republican from Rifle competes in a highly anticipated contest against [Diane Mitsch Bush](#) in the [3rd Congressional District](#), which spans western and southern Colorado.

"I'm proud to be endorsed by my hometown sheriff, Lou Vallario, who knows the strength of my character. The summary here is a small fine, not charged, charge dismissed, charge dropped," Boebert said Thursday, referring to the outcomes of her four cases. "In the meantime, Diane Mitsch Bush is intent on socializing our healthcare."

Boebert's first run-in with police was in the fall of 2010, after a neighbor, Michele Soet, alleged that Boebert, then 23, was harassing Soet and Soet's husband. The alleged harassment occurred in the days after Soet called police because Boebert's pit bulls were loose and threatening the life of her dogs.

Boebert was issued a ticket for dog code violations and a short time later texted Soet, "You have taken food out of my children's mouths," according to Soet. Boebert also "displayed her middle finger" to Soet's husband as he drove through Rifle, according to a Garfield County sheriff's deputy's report.

"I want to press charges against these irresponsible people, as it may save a life down the road," Soet wrote to the sheriff's office, referring to the Boeberts' loose pit bulls. Two days later, Boebert was handed a court summons by deputies but ultimately was never charged with harassment, according to court records.

As [first reported by Colorado Newsline](#), Boebert was detained on June 20, 2015, after a verbal altercation with police at Country Jam, a music festival near [Grand Junction](#). Boebert, then 28 years old, allegedly shouted at people detained on suspicion of underage drinking, urging them to flee from police, which caused the young drinkers to become unruly.

While she was being handcuffed for disorderly conduct, Boebert tried to twist away from police, according to deputies' reports. She allegedly shouted that her arrest was unconstitutional, that "she had friends at Fox News and that the arrest would be

6/23/24, 12:50 PM Boebert was released from custody and told to appear in court that August but missed her court date because, as she told a judge, she forgot what day of the week it was. "I am now aware today is Friday," she wrote on Aug. 28, 2015, hours after she was supposed to be in court.

The judge, Craig Henderson, rescheduled for later that year. But Boebert again was a no-show at a Nov. 20 hearing. In a handwritten note to the judge, she did not include a reason for her absence.

"I apologize for irresponsibly wasting the courts time with this matter. I want nothing more than to be finished with this case, as it is not something I keep on the forefront of my thinking," she wrote.

The court was less accommodating that time, records indicate. On Dec. 1, 2015, Boebert was arrested by sheriff's deputies for failure to appear, according to [Colorado Bureau of Investigation](#) arrest records. The next month, the disorderly conduct charge was dismissed because there was "no reasonable likelihood of conviction should (the) case go to trial," a prosecutor wrote at the time.

Failing to appear for court also landed Boebert in jail a year later. As [first reported by the Colorado Times Recorder](#), Boebert was charged with careless driving and operating an unsafe vehicle after rolling her truck into a Garfield County ditch in the summer of 2016. They were minor traffic charges, but Boebert skipped an October court date.

She was booked into the Garfield County Jail on the morning of Feb. 13, 2017, for failure to appear and spent exactly 100 minutes as an inmate before being released on bond, according to sheriff's office records. She later pleaded guilty to the unsafe vehicle charge, and the careless driving charge was dropped.

The man in charge of the jail then and now is Vallario, the Garfield County sheriff. Three years after Boebert was detained in the jail Vallario operates, he endorsed her campaign for Congress.

"I can tell you, I've worked with law enforcement members and two sheriffs who have had an arrest record in their past, from their younger days," Vallario said by phone Wednesday. "Maybe they made some bad decisions but turned out to be very fine people and great leaders."

Of Boebert's arrest record, the sheriff said, "To me, that doesn't represent somebody who is engaging in criminal behavior."

"We don't continue to punish people. That's what our criminal justice system is all about. Somebody does whatever they have to do or pays a penalty or pays a price, then they should be starting at the starting gate again and be able to change their life or move forward," Vallario said.

Boebert is the front-runner against Mitsch Bush, a Democrat, in the Republican-leaning 3rd District. Mitsch Bush has criticized Boebert's petty crimes, calling her behavior at Country Jam "disrespectful antics" that showed contempt for police and the rule of law.

"Lauren Boebert's hypocrisy is clear — she thinks the law doesn't apply to her," said Ashley Quenneville, Mitsch Bush's campaign manager. "If Boebert can't follow basic laws, how can Coloradans trust her to represent them with integrity as a member of Congress?"

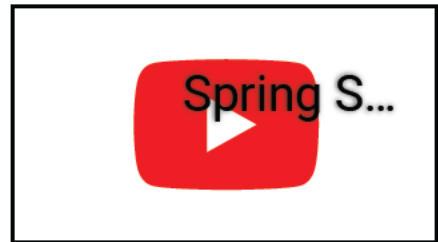

Lauren Boebert is a newly elected Republican congresswoman from Colorado who is adamant on her protecting her Second Amendment rights. A video was recently released of the Republican Congresswoman carrying her gun around Washington, D.C. “Even though I now work in one of the most liberal cities in America, I refuse to give up my rights,” Boebert

says in the video posted on Twitter on Sunday. “So as a five-foot-tall, 100-pound woman I choose to protect myself legally because I am my best security.”

Many are questioning Boebert’s choice to carry in D.C. and have been looking at firearm laws in D.C. and her home state of Colorado.

“I think we should look to D.C.’s laws because while she is in that state she is under the jurisdiction and she needs to obey the laws that are set in place in that area,” senior Trent Stacy said. “I do think that her claim is valid because if she feels as if her security and her ability to carry out her life in a safe manner are being threatened then I believe that she has every right

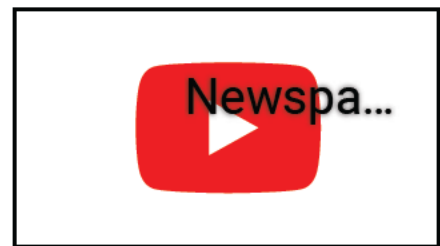

to defend herself. If someone/something is compromising her security then she has the ability to protect herself with whatever it may be.”

According to **USCCA**, D.C. is a shall-issue district with concealed weapons permits issued by D.C. Metropolitan Police. Here all firearms must be registered, and this process acts as a permit to purchase. Open carry (the ability to openly carry a firearm) is also illegal in D.C.

Colorado is a **shall-issue** state where concealed carry permits are issued to county residents by local sheriff's offices. No purchase permits or firearms registration are required for handguns. For transfers of firearms,

the seller must request that a licensed dealer perform a background check of the buyer and must get approval of the transfer from the Colorado Bureau of Investigation. Open carry is legal in Colorado for any person who is at least 18 years old and who can legally possess a firearm, while concealed carry is legal in Colorado for residents over 21 with a Colorado permit to carry a concealed weapon (CCW) and non-residents with a CCW permit from a state that Colorado honors. Clearly, Colorado permits more leniency of firearm rights and has more support for giving the full extent 2nd Amendment.

Boebert states that carry in D.C. is within her constitutional rights due to



the laws in Colorado, where she has a concealed carry license. But according to the D.C. Police Chief, she will still be accountable to the same penalties as anyone carrying a concealed weapon in D.C. According to [USA Carry](#), a resident concealed carry permit is only good so long as that person is a resident of that state but the permit does not transfer when you are in another state. Even if that state acknowledges someone's resident concealed carry permit from another state, it does not mean they will transfer it.

“I do think that as a woman in a position of power there is a need for extra protection, but only if used when absolutely necessary,” senior Hannah Hillis said. “Hopefully Lauren

Boebert is well trained and is aware of the consequences gun violence and self-protection can have. I think that everyone has a right to carry a gun, under the law, but I personally hope for more gun control. The tests, or lack thereof, to obtain a deadly weapon, are frightening to me. But

with better training requirements and other laws, we can make it safer to carry.”

It is relatable and understandable to many women across the country why a young woman would like to protect herself against potential harm, having to live in a country where approximately **1 in 5** (an estimated 25.5 million) women in the U.S. reported completed or attempted rape at some point in their lifetime. Additionally, alternative protection agents such as pepper spray and knives have been shown to be less effective in avoiding attacks and require the woman to get substantially closer to their attacker.

Boebert understands these threats and has witnessed the advantage of firearms after a violent attack at the restaurant she previously owned, but she also understands that D.C. has its own right to different firearm precautions. She states she has gone through the concealed carry courses that D.C. requires to obtain a concealed carry permit. Like a person learning the traffic laws in another state, Boebert sees her gun safety in the same light but fails to see why the Washing D.C police were threatened enough to release a statement that she has to be informed of their laws.

In the end, Boebert will not remain resistant to Washington, D.C.'s laws as a spokesperson for Boebert stated she will “comply with all applicable

firearm laws and regulations.” Boebert should be pleased with new rules revealed by House Speaker Nancy Pelosi which did not include a proposed ban on firearms in the Capitol that 21 Democratic lawmakers pushed to keep Boebert from carrying her gun to work.
